

What Is That? – Burlington, Elementary School



In 2004 a 5th grade field trip was visiting the Royal Botanical Gardens in Hamilton Ontario. It was a blustery day and the children on the trip were touring the wooded gardens area. One of the particularly strong gusts of wind cracked a section of a large tree; and when it fell to the ground it landed on Tyler Cooper, one of the students on the field trip. Tyler died at the gardens. Charles R. Beaudion School in Burlington was a new school and the community was devastated by the student's death. In honor of Tyler, who loved everything to do with sports, the school dedicated the gymnasium to the young boy.

It seems Tyler hung around long enough to be a part of this performance, as well.
