INVESTIGATOR'S SUMMARY OF EVENTS:

We all arrived via separate cars at approximately 2:30 pm. Several photographs, video, Gauss meter, and temperature readings were taken while we toured the cemetery. Nothing out of the ordinary was recorded. Carol thought she might have picked up something usual on her video, but the video has not been evaluated at this point.

Conclusion: No evidence of paranormal activity.

History of the Location

The Uniontown Cemetery is located about six tenths of a mile from Lotus on Bassi Road. Cemetery visitor parking seems to be located on personally owned property. The cemetery was established in the 1850s and served the town of Marshall which was an early gold and silver mining town. A slice of the American River can be viewed upon entering the cemetery grounds.

The town of Lotus was originally called Marshall. It was changed to Uniontown in 1855. In 1861 it was changed again to Lotus, which it has remained ever since. El Dorado County purchased the property in 1879.

The cemetery is in a state of disrepair. However, a number of stones are in good condition considering their age.
